





 - ▶ Some schools may use the College Board's IDOC (Institutional **D**ocumentation Service) to collect tax documents
 - ▶ This service started November 1
 - ▶ Provides your tax data and imaged tax documents for institutions

Commonly Asked Questions

One parent claims me, but I live with the other

- ▶ It does not matter who claims the student on the tax return
- ▶ The parent who provides information on the PROFILE is the parent
 - ▶ You live with the most
 - ▶ If you live with both parents equally, the parent who provides the most support

My parents filed their taxes together in 2015, but are now separated

- ▶ Income should be broken out
 - ▶ Income earned by the reporting parent is reported at 100%
 - ▶ Income earned jointly is reported at 50%
 - ▶ Taxes paid can be reported at 50%
- ▶ Explanation should be provided in Section ES
- ▶ NCAN has helpful worksheets
 - ▶ <http://www.collegeaccess.org/FilingtheFAFSA>
- ▶ Seek guidance from your financial aid officer at your college or colleges

How do I estimate my asset values?

- ▶ Cash, savings and investments are reported at their value as of the date of your application
- ▶ The family home, other real estate, businesses, or farms are reported as amount you would expect to receive if you were to sell the asset today
 - ▶ Fair market value, not the tax assessed value
 - ▶ Sites like zillow.com can help for your home value

How do I report my debt?

- ▶ Debt on an asset is any mortgage, lien, or outstanding debt against the asset
 - ▶ Home debt would include mortgage plus any credit line amount actually used
- ▶ Credit card debt or loans not taken out against an asset are not reported

What happens if I have more than one child in college?

- ▶ If you have more than one in college, you will need to submit an aid application for each child
 - ▶ FAFSA for both
 - ▶ PROFILE for both only if required by each college
- ▶ Having more than one in college will impact the parental contribution

My situation is really unusual. What do I do?

- ▶ If you have anything that is out of the ordinary, you should share that information with the financial aid office at your colleges
- ▶ It is important to understand that only the financial aid office at each of your colleges can make decisions on how to respond to your situation
