

Creating a CSS Profile Account for Parent Use

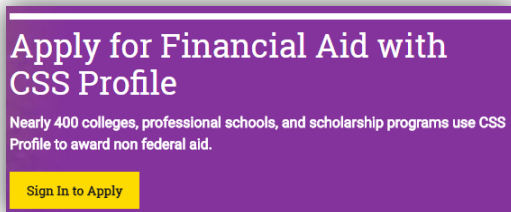
To complete a CSS Profile, you need to have a College Board **student** account. This can be confusing when you need to complete the CSS Profile as a **parent** (for example, as a noncustodial parent). Below are important tips and instructions to help you create an account as a parent.

Important Tips

- * **Create the account using your (the parent's) information, not the student's**
- * **On the "Getting Started" screen of the CSS Profile, update the pre-filled information (name & email address) to the student's information**

Creating an Account

1. Go to <https://cssprofile.collegeboard.org/>
2. Click **Sign In to Apply** in the header of the page



3. Select the application award year (e.g. **Sign In 2018-19**)
4. Click **Sign Up**
5. Complete the form **using your (the parent's) information, not your student's information.**

Note: You only need to provide information marked by a red asterisk*.

Accessing the CSS Profile Application

1. Go to <https://cssprofile.collegeboard.org/>
2. Click **Sign In to Apply** in the header of the page
3. Select the application award year
4. Sign in using the account you created
