Receive individual FREE help in completing the FAFSA online by our trained counselors.

To complete the FAFSA, please bring:

- Social security number for parents and student (or permanent resident number)
- Date of Birth of parents and student
- Date of Marriage of parents
- Date you moved to Virginia
- W-2 forms or other wage statements
- Current statements for checking, savings and other asset accounts
- Investment records, including 529 plans or other prepaid college plans
- Your 2017 federal tax return
- Alien registration card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Military Families: LES (student and/or parents) for any month in 2017
- Driver's license number if you have one
- An FSA ID must be created for both the student and one parent. You may obtain your FSA ID at <https://fsaid.ed.gov>
