A general explanation of the information required on the CSS Profile and filing due dates. For seniors and parents of seniors who are attending a school which requires the CSS Profile. Please check the link on our website to see if your school requires this form.

****For those who need to complete the CSS Profile, we strongly recommend that you first attend the FAFSA Line-by-Line workshop so that you are familiar with the process.****
