



# Are you a Senior completing FAFSA?

Let's gather everything you need to get started.

- Social security number for parents & students (or permanent resident number)
- Two unique email addresses (one for the student & one for the parent)
- An FSA ID for both the student & one parent. (<https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/sign-in/landing>)
- Alien registration card (if you are not a US Citizen)
- Date of birth of parents & students
- Parents' date of marriage (and divorce, if applicable)
- Date you moved to Virginia
- Drivers license (if you have one)
- 2020 W-2 forms or other wage statements
- 2020 Completed tax returns
- Current statements for checking, savings & other asset accounts
- Current investment records, including 529 plans or other prepaid college plans
- Military Families: LES (student and/or parents) for any month in 2020
